Are YOU or your CHILDREN UNINSURED?

You May Be Eligible For Catamount Health, VHAP, Or Dr. Dynasaur

Who is eligible for Catamount Health and VHAP?

You are **IMMEDIATELY** eligible for Catamount Health or VHAP if you are 18 or older and:

- have been uninsured for at least 12 months
- OR**
- lost your insurance because you retired, lost or quit your job
 - had your hours at work reduced
 - got divorced, or your civil union dissolved
 - are no longer a dependent
 - left college
 - no longer choose to receive COBRA or VIPER
 - the policy holder died
 - you have had an individual plan for 6 months with a deductible of at least \$10,000

Who is eligible for Dr. Dynasaur?

Dr. Dynasaur is for children up to age 18 and pregnant women.

How much do Catamount Health and VHAP cost?

Monthly premiums are based on your gross household monthly income only, not your assets. Premiums for these programs range from \$0 to \$185/month with little or no other out of pocket costs.

How do I apply?

You can get an application for Dr. Dynasaur, VHAP, and Catamount Health by contacting any of the numbers below, or on-line at www.catamounthealth.org. *You can apply up to 60 days before you lose your health insurance.*
