Jambo means hello in Swahili and is one of the languages spoken by students in Kenya, Africa. The Child-to-Child Art Exchange is a project started in 2006 by Cacky Peltz, a retired Vermont art teacher and Woodbury resident. This art exchange project has provided students in Vermont and Kenya opportunities to learn about each and share their artwork. If you would like to learn more about Kenya, a country in eastern Africa and participate in the art exchange please sign up for the afterschool workshop series. During the workshops students will begin each afternoon class learning about Kenya through slides of Cacky's trip to Kenya, learning about the arts of eastern Africa, by sharing simple African foods, learning some simple Swahili vocabulary and more. The majority of the workshop time will be spent in making a picture book to share with students in Nyalgunga village in Kenya including mask making.

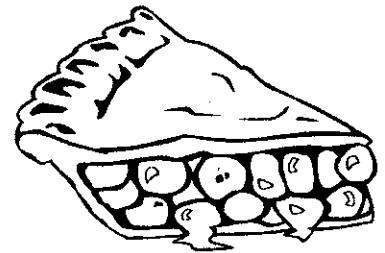
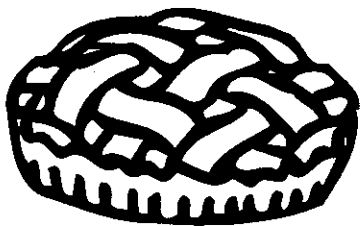
